

Application Form for Matching Scholarships towards tuition

For students in the PACT division, The EGS offers a Matching Scholarship program, in which the university matches money raised by the student up to a limit of \$2,000 per student per year. The money to be matched may be raised from any scholarship-providing organization – bank and government loans are not eligible for matching funds. The distribution of matching scholarships depends on available funds and will be disbursed to qualifying students on a first-come, first-served basis.

The EGS PACT Matching Scholarship program will begin with the 2017-18 academic year, and the first disbursements can be applied to tuition for classes in the following sessions: Malta October 2017, Saas-Fee June 2018, Saas-Fee August 2018, Malta October 2018.

Applications may be submitted immediately.

Please note: for an application to be considered, the student applying for a matching scholarship must already have been admitted and must have registered for an MA or PhD program in the Division of Philosophy, Art and Critical Thought (PACT).
